

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF FALLOWFIELD TOWNSHIP, PENNA.

Whereas, we the undersigned, do hereby resolve to establish a fund from which to provide payment of benefits to qualified, full time members of the Fallowfield Township Police Department and thier Families and survivors. The fund shall be titled "The Police Pension Fund of Fallowfield Township". The board of supervisors shall assume full responsibility in the administration of the police pension fund and shall govern payment of benefits to all duly qualified recipients with due diligence and dispatch.

PENSION BENEFITS

A. Qualification; Police department member must have 18 (eighteen) years of service on full time basis. He must be at least 55 years of age.

B. Formula for Determining benefits:

Pension income at retirees' age 55 shall be 32 1/2 % of the average salary in the five (5) years predeing date of retirement. An increment factor of 3.2% shall be added to the 32 1/2 % base for each year beyond age 55 of the retiree, up to age 64.

Retirement at age 65 shall be 65 % of the average salary of the five (5) years preceding the date of retirement.

C. Social Security Integration:

All retiring qualified members of the police department who are covered under the Social Security Law at the date of retirement shall have their respective retirement benefit allowance applied toward the total amount of pension due him in calculating the benefit from the above stated formula. The pension benfit shall be a combination of Social Security Benefit and Police Pension Fund Benefit up to the appropriate level of the particular retiree.

Loss of Social Security Benefit by survivor of retired member who deceases within ten years of date of retirement, shall not be assumed by the Township of Fallowfield.

The portion of the pensioners' total income allocated from the Police Pension Fund, shall be Gauranteed for his lifetime and for ten years certain to his survivors.

D. Death Benefits.

The named beneficiaries of a full time qualified member of the Fallowfield Township Police Department who deceases prior to his retirement date, shall recieve benefits as follows:

(\$3,000.) Three Thousand dollars as soon as reasonably possible following the death of a qualified member of the police dept.; and \$ 265.00 , per month or \$3,180 per year for the next ten years.

The retiree, on his date of retirement, shall be granted a fully paid up insurance policy in the amount of \$2,000 with him as the named insured and his designation of beneficiary.

E. FUNDING:

The obligations assumed by the Board of Supervisors of Fallowfield Township by reason of enactment and adoption of this resolution are to be funded by an insurance contract with a reputable insurance company.

F. CONFORMITY TO STATE STATUTES:

Should any portion or provision of this resolution be in conflict with any statute of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, this resolution is hereby amended to conform to the minimum requirements of such ~~statute~~.

WHEREAS, the amount of future construction of Primary and Secondary highways and upgraded Interstate highways presently in the planning stages will require the continued use of Federal funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we do hereby request that Congress adopts the necessary legislation to assure the uninterrupted continuation of federal aid to highways after 1972, including but not limited to the following points:

- (1) Continue the Highway Trust Fund through 1985, keeping the Fund inviolate for highway purposes only as in the past.
- (2) Continue the ABC (primary and secondary roads) and TOPICS (Traffic Operations Programs to Increase Capacity and Safety).
- (3) Consider new programs for Highway Trust Fund financing, including highway safety, equal-employment training, highway oriented mass transit facilities, a bridge replacement program and a railroad grade crossing elimination program.
- (4) Establish a bridge replacement program to replace critically deficient and obsolete bridges and to build additional crossings over major waterways.
- (5) Provide for the Federal share of preliminary engineering costs to be paid to the States on a fixed percentage-of-construction-costs basis.
- (6) Tighten legislation so as to assure proper flow of federal funds and to prevent arbitrary freezes and delays.
- (7) Direct a study to improve effectiveness of Federal-State highway partnership through cooperation of the Federal Highway Administration and State Highway Departments, with due consideration for the roles of local governments.
